

Key Information for Students Publishing rules

Handy rules for publishing the full KIS (and KIS Button) on your website.

Overview

The STEO system allows registration of qualifications for funding purposes. The NZQA system registers approved qualifications and lists them on the NZQF. These two systems are independent and your interactions with STEO (TEC) and NZQF (NZQA or UNZ) are handled separately. A qualification may be 'active' in STEO and 'discontinued' on the NZQF.

The Careers NZ website is the central location for the publication of the Key Information for Students (KIS). Users will continue to search for information about qualifications on this website as they have previously but they will now be able to find the KIS information here also.

The KIS Button on a TEO website will link to the KIS page on the Careers NZ website. If a qualification is available in the KIS Data Service (API) then the URL linking the KIS Button to the central website will always work. A search on the Careers NZ website will only display qualifications that are 'active' in STEO and 'current' on the NZQF. A qualification will not be discoverable using the Careers NZ search if the qualification status on the NZQF has changed to 'expiring' or 'discontinued'.

Note: a KIS page will be available on the central website (Careers NZ) for all qualifications at level 5 and above while a qualification is still 'active' in STEO.

The rules below outline if a KIS will be published for a qualification on a TEO website, how qualifications will be handled on the central website, through the search function and if a KIS link will be available.
