

Fees Free info sheet: How to check an NSN for Fees Free eligibility

This document sets out the two different ways to check a learner's National Student Number (NSN) to find out if they're eligible for Fees Free study and/or training.

Option one: Look up a list of confirmed eligible NSNs and a list of NSNs that have changed to or from "Yes"

Step	Action
1	Log into <u>Workspace 2</u> .
	If you don't have access to Workspace 2, you can request access by completing and submitting the <u>Education Sector Logon Tertiary Application User Access Request</u> <u>Form</u> . When completing the form, in Part 4 select Tertiary Education Commission (TEC) Shared Workspaces.
2	Go to the Notices section on your Home page.
	To see a list of all NSNs that have been assessed as eligible for Fees Free tertiary study:
	 select Fees Free Eligibility to download the file FreesFreeEligibility.csv.
	To see a list of all NSNs whose eligibility has changed to or from "Yes" ¹ since the launch of Fees Free:
	• select Fees Free Eligibility Changes to download the file EligibilityYChanges.csv
	Both these lists are updated each TEC business day.
3	Press CTRL + F to open the search window.
4	Type in the NSN you are looking for and press Enter or click Find Next.
5	If the NSN is found then the NSN is eligible for Fees Free. Record the outcome. Ends.

¹ A learner's status may change to or from yes for a number of reasons including the learner completing their statutory declaration with incorrect information

or

If the NSN is not found then the NSN is either not eligible or may be eligible with further information. Proceed to Option two.

Option two: To check small numbers of NSNs, look up individual NSNs on feesfree.govt.nz

Step	Action
1	Go to the <u>Fees Free website</u> .
2	Enter the learner's NSN.
3	Select the relevant year, type of education and select whether the learner is a school leaver or a non-school leaver.
	Which year should I choose?
	• If the learner is starting Fees Free eligible study or training in the 2020 calendar year, select the 2020 study year.
	• If the learner is starting Fees Free eligible study or training in the 2021 calendar year, select the 2021 study year.
	Should I look at the eligibility criteria for provider-based study or for industry training?
	 If the learner is studying or training at Te Pūkenga, private training establishments, universities or wānanga, see the eligibility criteria for provider based study.
	 If the learner is doing an apprenticeship through Te Pūkenga or a private training establishment see the eligibility criteria for provider-based study.
	 If the learner is doing an apprenticeship or work based training, see the eligibility criteria for industry training.
	Should I look at the eligibility criteria for a school leaver or a non-school leaver?
	 Choose school leaver if the learner has been enrolled in school within the two years preceding the year they are first enrolled in tertiary education.
	Choose non-school leaver if the learner hasn't been enrolled in a school in the past two years
