

UFS Mixed Mode of Delivery

(a combination of Work-based & Provider-based delivery)

Mere begins an **apprenticeship** with a building company and is supported in her Work-Based training by the TEO.



As part of her apprenticeship, Mere enrolls in a 'Working at Heights' **block course**



Mere has completed her apprenticeship and is now a fully qualified builder



Enrol the learner in **ITR** and include in ITR submissions for each month for the duration of training.*

No change to coding for UFS.

Enrol the learner in **SDR** and include in SDR submissions for the duration of their Provider-Based (block course) study. Use **SoF11** and **ATTEND** codes to identify provider-based or extramural modes of delivery.
