## **Mixed-mode instructions**

#### **Definition**

Mixed-mode delivery refers to provider-based aspects (including provider-based: extramural) of otherwise work-based training arrangements, eg. block courses or night classes.

This template must be completed by TEOs that submit data through the Industry Training Register (ITR) if any of the learners undertake provider-based learning as part of their work-based training programme.

The provider-based learning must be submitted to the TEC via the Single Data Return (SDR), under source of funding (SOF) 11.

The work-based learning must be submitted to TEC via the Industry Training Register (ITR) reporting system.

The data in this template will enable the TEC to match the data from the SDR with the relevant data in the ITR. This will enable to correct recognition of the volume and value of delivery in work-based and provider-based respectively.

• This template will accept multiple SDR Provider-based EDUMIS codes.
